

## **Directions to training locations:**

### **Allegany County Health Department**

12501 Willowbrook Rd.

Cumberland, MD 21501 (301) 759-5082

Take I-70 West from Baltimore about 100 miles to Hancock. Exit at Interstate 68 West and go about 35 miles to Cumberland. Take Willowbrook Road exit and turn left onto Willowbrook Road. Allegany County Health Dept. is on the left in the Willowbrook Office Complex. Park on the right side of the building. Enter the front door of the main building and you will be directed to the assigned conference room.

### **Anne Arundel County Department of Health**

Take I-695 (Baltimore Beltway) to I-97 South (Exit 4). Take I-97 to Rte. 50 East (towards Annapolis Bay Bridge). Stay in right lane to Exit 22 (Rte. 665 – Aris T. Allen Blvd.). Take Riva Rd. Exit. Turn right onto Riva Rd. – proceed to third traffic light (Shell gas station on left). Turn right onto Harry S. Truman Parkway. Health Services Bldg. is .5 mile on left.

From I-695 (Baltimore Beltway) take the York Road South exit. Continue through Towson for about 2 miles beyond the circle. The Drumcastle Center is on the left, just past the light at Dunkirk Rd. Do not park in the shopping center lot. Additional parking is available behind the shopping center if the Health Dept. lot is full.

From I-695 (Baltimore Beltway South) take I-97 towards Annapolis. Exit at Route 3 South (later becomes Rte. 301) and go about 20 miles. Turn south on Rte. 4 at Upper Marlboro toward Prince Frederick and go about 30 miles. Turn left on Stokely Road toward Calvert Memorial Hospital. Take the first right to get to the health department building.

### **Carroll County Health Department**

From I-695, take exit 19 to merge onto NW Expy/I-795 N toward Owings Mills/Reisterstown. Take exit 9B to merge onto MD-140 W/Westminster Rd/Westminster Pike toward Westminster. Stay on 140 until the intersection of Center Street and 140. Turn left on Center Street and follow Center Street all the way to the Health Department.

### **Garrett County Health Department**

Take I-70 West from Baltimore about 100 miles to Hancock. Exit at I-68 West and go about 35 miles to Cumberland. Continue on I-68 30 miles past Cumberland to Exit 14-A (Rt. 219 South). Pass Deep Creek Lake and continue on Route 219 South for another 10 miles to Oakland. The first stoplight is the entrance to Walmart. Turn left at the second stoplight (CVS Pharmacy is on the right) and proceed approximately one mile past the Garrett County Memorial Hospital to the Garrett County Health Center on the left across from Regional Eye Center.

From I-95: Driving North or South on I-95, take Rte. 175 (Columbia-Jessup) exit 41-B. Follow Rte. 175 West (0.25 miles) to Gateway Drive exit. Go about 0.5 miles to 6-story office building on left.

South on I-95 to the DC Beltway, I-495. Take the I-495 West, Exit number 27-25 on the right, towards US-1/College Park/Silver Spring. Take the I-495 West, exit number 2 on the right, toward Silver Spring. Merge onto Capital Beltway/I-495 W. Exit I-495 at the MD-97 North/Georgia Avenue exit, exit number 31A on the right, toward Wheaton. Merge onto Georgia Avenue/MD-97. Go 0.8 miles to third stop light at Dennis Avenue. Turn right onto Dennis Avenue. There is a brick medical center building at the corner of Dennis Avenue. Drive 0.2 miles to your destination at 2000 Dennis Avenue; health department is on the right. Parking is available in lots at the front and side of the building.

## Overview

Tuberculosis (TB) continues to be a leading cause of death worldwide. Despite the general decline of TB in this country, TB persists in high risk populations. An essential component of TB control is the administration and interpretation of the tuberculin skin test (TST). Because the TST is subject to variability, it is important that health care workers who place and read TST's attend training. This course is designed for both the novice at TB skin testing and for professionals who need to update skills.

## Objectives

After completing the workshop the participant will be able to:

- Place, measure, and interpret the Mantoux skin test according to CDC and Maryland guidelines;
- Use a patient's history to make appropriate skin test interpretations;
- Describe the HIV/TB connection, reactor/convertor cut-points, two-step testing, anergy, and BCG;
- Make initial case management decisions in simple and complex situations involving suspected TB infection.
